

Contest Rules

- 1. Bring a 4-oz. sample for each honey you will enter into the contest.

 Participants must be registered to attend the Fall Conference &
 Workshops. Honey entered into the contest must be 100% unadulterated
 Indiana honey. The honey will be judged for taste only. Your sample(s)
 will not be returned.
- 2. Contestants will transfer their honey into 2 2-oz. black jars (provided).
- 3. <u>Jar 1</u>: sampled by honey judges. <u>Jar 2</u>: sent to Purdue for analysis.
- 4. Purdue will test each sample to determine the pollen types in your honey sample(s). Participants will receive the results of these tests via email.
- 5. Contest registration 7:15a to 9:30a **SHARP**. You will need to provide the hive location, approximate extraction date, and complete an entry sheet when dropping off the same to be judged on the day of the conference.
- 6. The Black Jar Honey Contest award will begin at 11:15a contestants must be present to win. Entry forms will be available at the table where the samples are collected.
